

**International Single Species Action Plan for the Western Palearctic  
Population of the LESSER WHITE-FRONTED GOOSE, *Anser erythropus***

**Comments from FRANCE on Version 3.0. - Third and Final Draft, May 2008**

This refers to the draft International Species Action Plan for the Conservation of the Lesser Whited-fronted Goose (*Anser erythropus*) that the AEWA Secretariat circulated to the Parties.

France would like to make the following comments to the text:

- On page 36, France proposes that a bullet point on poisoning be added to Paragraph **e. "Knowledge Limitation"**. This factor is also mentioned in Table 2a at the following page. The issue deserves particular attention.

- on page 97, Annex 5 XXXII, the footnote under the table refers to "reintroduced population in France and Italy". To our knowledge, there is no reintroduction programme for this species in France. Could you please provide the source of this information as it might be a mistake.
