## STATUS OF DOCUMENT PRODUCTION FOR THE 7<sup>th</sup> SESSION OF THE MEETING OF THE PARTIES (MOP7)

This paper provides an overview of the progress of the document production for the 7<sup>th</sup> Session of the Meeting of the Parties to AEWA. It covers the mandatory documents as per the legal text of the Agreement and other documents mandated by previous sessions of the MOP which depend on external support and/or funding. It excludes newly drafted or revised species action or management plans, reports by governing bodies and the Secretariat, including on the Implementation Review Process, proposals for amendments to the Agreement and its annexes, other documents, usually produced in-house by the Secretariat, such as on institutional, administrative and budgetary issues.

## **Action Requested from the Standing Committee:**

The Standing Committee is requested to take note of the documents to be submitted for MOP7 and their respective progress of production. Attention is required particularly for the mandatory reviews (rows 1-5 in the table below), which may need to be cancelled if funding is not provided within the following three months to allow for timely commissioning. The Standing Committee is invited to provide guidance to the Secretariat, as necessary.
