#### ARRIVAL AT HELSINKI-VANTAA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

The easiest way to get into the city from Helsinki-Vantaa International Airport is to take the **Finnair bus** which leaves directly outside of the Terminal 2 arrivals hall on ground level. The bus leaves every 20 minutes and costs approximately 6€ per person one way. The drive into Helsinki takes 35 minutes and the bus stops at the central train station right in the middle of town. From there you will be able to reach most inner city hotels by foot or with the tram.
